BOARD MINUTES

JANUARY 6, 2021

DUE TO THE ONGOING COVID PANDEMIC, THE MEETING WAS HELD VIA TELECONFERENCE

Minutes of the December meeting were accepted.

Treasurer's report was accepted. Note was made that we received \$400 in dues and \$1,800 in donations, including \$500 from Dance Unlimited who had used our facility for a recital.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Facilities: new accessible bathroom has been completed.

Newsletter: We are changing our bulk mail permit per the new vendor. Old permit number is no longer valid.

Patrons: One new patron this month at the \$250 level. Patron letter is to be sent out inviting patrons to stream Almost Maine without charge.

Scholarship: Letter is ready to go. Question was raised as to which logo to use on the letterhead. Consensus was that letterheads with the old logo could be used until they are gone. A new logo is being developed.

Social Media: We received \$750 from the Facebook from the Giving Tuesday promotion. No receipts as of yet from the birthday donations.

OLD BUSINESS:

Facility name. Action is deferred until final results of polling are in. Newsletter gives those interested until Jan 15 to respond.

We are still reviewing several vendors. There is no recommendation yet. Motion was made to table this issue until we have reviewed our experience with the vendor we are using for Almost Maine. Motion, Mumford, second, Mullins.

ASCAP form is due. It needs attendance numbers from the outdoor musicals. Question was raised as to whether we should renew the license now. WE will renew the license as long as we are sure that the fee covers the shows we did. Motion, Nagel second, Mumford.

NEW BUSINESS:

Almost Maine will begin filming on Jan 18. Help is needed with set building and painting this weekend.

Unproduced shows: At this point there was no longer a quorum, so no decision was made as to the shows. There was consensus that the Production Committee should discuss the issue, and that also the Production Committee should consider further programming such as streaming, outdoor events, etc. that we could do as long as we are unable to do live indoor theater.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
